

Belleayre Mountain Ski Resort, known as New York's Winter Snow Park, has 38 trails serviced by eight lifts with close to 200 skiable acres and 96% snowmaking coverage. It's here that enthusiasts can ski the highest skiable peak, the longest skiable trail and the only Cat access skiing in the Catskill Mountains. The Upper Mountain lifts bring you to Belleayre's 3,429-foot summit, the start of intermediate and expert trails flanked on the west by the Deer Run Trail and on the east by Cat access glade skiing, a 2.2 mile run from summit to Base Lodge and the challenging double diamond Cathedral Brook trail. The separate but connected beginner novice area boasts 10 trails serviced by five lifts. Recognized as being one of the best places to learn to ski on the East Coast, Belleayre has expanded its teaching facilities, increased its teaching staff and still offers free beginner lessons with the purchase of any lift ticket for skiers age 5 and older. Belleayre also has miles and miles of cross-country and snowshoe trails.



Directions from Hunter:

Rt 23A East to Rt 214. Make Right Turn onto Rt 214. Take Rt 214 South to Phoenicia. Take Rt 28 West to Highmount, NY. Look for signs for Belleayre.
